We extend a warm welcome to our opponents today in the latest round of fixtures in the Tribute Western Counties West League. This is a massive bottom of the table clash; newly promoted St Ives, more used to higher status in past years and determined to hold their own in this league, against a club that has rarely faltered since joining it in 2004.

Bude have come a long way since their first match against HMS Raleigh at Devonport in January 1966. As a colt in the early 1970's, I remember the match was played on a cow field. It was 1985 before the club secured its own ground and clubhouse on Bencoolen Meadows. Bude RFC is a registered Community Amateur Sports Club. The conditions, as I write, are forecast to be difficult again at the weekend. Welcoming the referee, we trust that Mr Andrew Reynolds will add to an entertaining afternoon. Don't forget to pop in to the clubhouse after for a hot drink or a cold beer.
