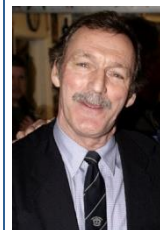

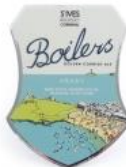
Past Player profile: Mike Rowe **Position:** No.8
