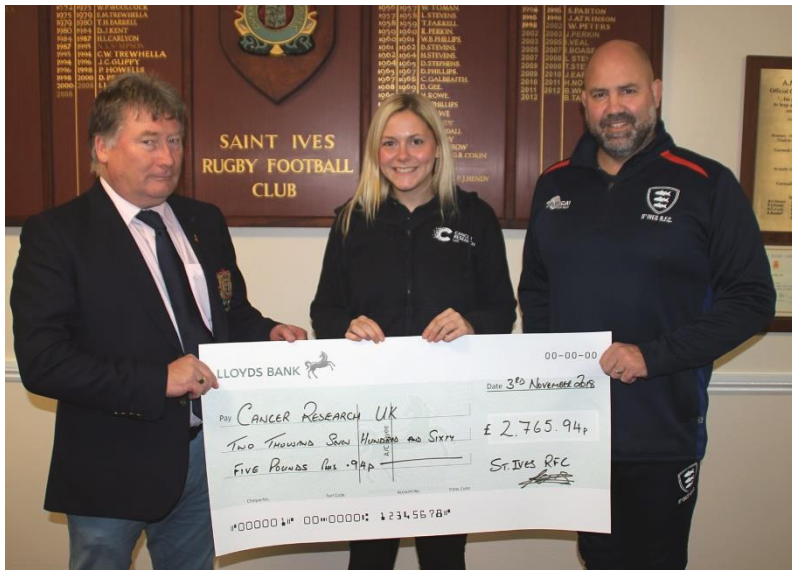


Recent results for St Ives and Launceston
