St Ives has produced a series of excellent results this season, remaining unbeaten in the league, playing highly entertaining rugby. Today we welcome Crediton back to The Recreation Ground, our first meeting for 8 seasons. They finished 6th last season and 4th in 2010-11 in this league. They were champions once during the league's 25 year history in 1988. St Ives played against Crediton in The Western Counties (west) league in the 2003-4 season, when St Ives gained promotion through the play-offs against Thornbury.
