### Recent History

Tiverton have had the best of recent matches between the two clubs. In the 2012-13 season the clubs faced each other in the Cornwall & Devon league. Tiverton missed out on promotion, finishing 3<sup>rd</sup>, behind St Ives, who were runners up. Honours were even with a wins at home; 41:12 and 50:8. The following season saw Tiverton promoted. They have remained in this league since then. In 2014-15 they finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Western Counties league, registering big wins over struggling St Ives to the tune of 37:0 and 53:0. Last year they were mid table with thirteen wins and thirteen defeats, finishing 6<sup>th</sup>.

Today is sure to be an engaging contest between two well matched sides.
